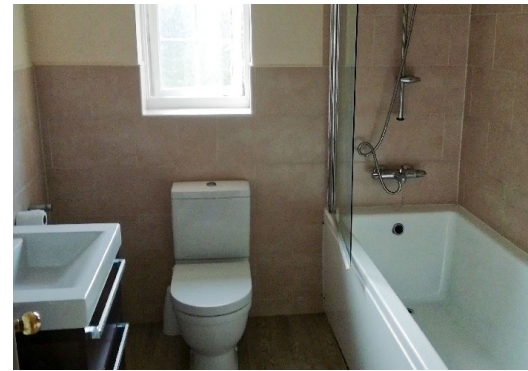


# Larch Rise

The property itself is surrounded by private gardens in a quiet residential location. The vacant bedroom is located on the first floor of the property and has shared access to a bathroom, kitchen, living room and conservatory.

Larch Rise also benefits from being in the same town as Autism Plus' day service/social enterprise Easi Works – offering vocational placements in horticulture and hospitality as well as pet therapy.
