Thorne House is a grand 18 bed residential home divided into five apartments, based in the thriving town of Thorne, South Yorkshire. We currently have a vacancy in our 3 bed 'Church View' apartment, the vacant bedroom is located on the first floor of the property and communal kitchen, sitting room and bathroom are located on the second floor. Please note that the rooms are all accessed via stairs so are unsuitable for those with mobility issues.

The vacancy at Thorne House is suitable for either a male or female with a diagnosis of Autism, learning disability and/or additional complex needs.

As well as having access to the residential home's communal areas and extensive grounds, the individual could also benefit from elements of specialist support from our wider team, including but not limited to: Speech and Language Therapist (SALT), Occupational Therapist, Positive Behaviour Support and Clinical Care.

Thorne House is situated within walking distance of the town centre with its range of amenities including supermarkets, doctor's surgery, pharmacy, hair salons and cafes. It also benefits from being located on the Hull - Doncaster - Sheffield trainline and on multiple bus routes.
